

## UPDATE TO STAKEHOLDERS ON COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES TAKEN BY BDC – 24 MARCH 2020

As of March 2020, the outbreak of the prevalent coronavirus (COVID-19) has been declared a public health emergency of international concern by the World Health Organisation (WHO). In view of the call to action by Government and the steep growth of cases in our trading partners and neighbouring countries BDC has now put in place heightened measures to protect its employees, clientele and broader stakeholders.
